

NEW CLIMATE AGREEMENT ACHIEVED IN LOKI'S UBN HEADQUARTERS



Vetus Novus had a turbulent period concerning its political preferences with regard to climate change. Many protests have taken place in the past months, because some Vetus Novis were not pleased with the way the concilium and the nine inferiors dealt with the situation.

According to the protesters, the politicians only cared about the profit for the economy and their country, and not about the impact. Although many measures already protect the climate, such as a strict no-driving zone in the larger cities, the protesters are not satisfied.

To calm down the situation, a UBN meeting was organised by Vetus Novus yesterday, Saturday 13 November at the UBN headquarters in Loki. The delegates from Whenua, Ebrana, Nomen, Avélie, F.R.E.D., Suderaka, Damisa, Cryondia, Hama'Lu and Vetus Novus itself were all represented.

For the time being, they have not yet released an official report on what was actually decided yesterday. What is already clear is that from 2030 onwards, only electric cars will be sold in the UBN. On top of that, there will be extra taxes on air travel. Public transport will also become cheaper, to encourage people to use it more often.

The protestants are satisfied with the new measures. They hope they have made it clear that the climate is extremely important, and that we must take care of it. Tempers have calmed down for the moment.
